

Case

- 10 year old boy, known acute leukemia
- Fever 1 day, vomit x 3, poor feeding
- At ER: lethargy, maintainable airway
- BT 39 C, BP 80/40 mmHg, HR 130/min
- RR 24/min, SpO₂ 95%
- Warm extremities, bounding pulse
- Diagnosis ?
