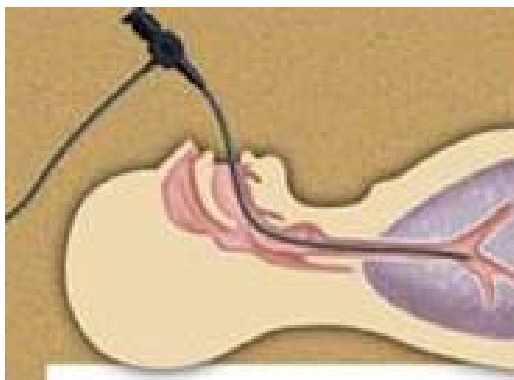

Common indications

- Atelectasis
- Stridor
- Unexplained or persistent wheeze/ cough
- Recurrent pneumonia
- Persistent radiographic infiltrates
- Suspected airway compression or obstruction

Common indications

- Hemoptysis/ epistaxis
- Suspected congenital anomalies
- Suspected vocal cord paralysis
- Persistent hoarseness
- Suspected FB aspiration
